Additionally, over the past decade, Corteva has made targeted investments in our supply strategy and infrastructure. We remain confident in our ability to address customer needs for Enlist One herbicide for 2022.

Corteva continues to invest heavily in new trait technologies and we're all excited about what's in the pipeline. It's just what you should expect from a company that's 100% focused on ag.
