

Christ the King School History

60 years ago, with the ground breaking on January 26, 1961 and construction completed in the fall, our parochial school opened its doors in September of 1961. Sr. Geraldine Mary arrived with three other sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet. We began with four grades and added one more each year until the first 8th grade graduated in 1966. In 1975 we added a kindergarten. In 1998 the school was expanded and a 6th, 7th and 8th grade wing was built. In 1999 an electrical fire broke out, and the damage was extreme and severe. The school was rebuilt as a state of the art school for the 21st century. On September 9, 2000 we celebrated the blessing and opening of our newly rebuilt school. In 2021 our school continues to thrive!
