

### Dear Friends:

The World Day of Social Justice was observed on February 20. Initiated in 2007, the United Nations General Assembly established the World Day of Social Justice to promote efforts of the international community in poverty eradication, promotion of full employment and decent work, gender equity, and access to social well-being and justice for all.

The Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church offers "a complete overview of the fundamental framework of the doctrinal corpus of Catholic social teaching". It reminds us: "A just society can become a reality only when it is based on the respect of the transcendent dignity of the human person. The person represents the ultimate end of society. The social order and its development must invariably work to the benefit of the human person... not the other way around...It is necessary to consider every neighbor without exception as another self, taking into account first of all his life and the means necessary for living it with dignity ...Every political, economic, social, scientific and cultural program must be inspired by the awareness of the primacy of each human being over society."

Love of God and neighbor requires that we play our part in our homes, communities, nation, and world to promote social justice equity, equality, and inclusion. The biblical parables of the Rich Man and Lazarus (Luke 16:19-31), and the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37) are worth studying. We cannot be indifferent in the face of injustice.



The promotion of right relationships requires us to reject greed, individualism, and other forms of 'isms'. Conscience formation is critical if we are to embrace the right values. "Our consciences... need to be converted to justice, equality, simplicity and sharing" (Pope Francis). The season of Lent is a time when we form our conscience in the ways of justice and love.

As one of the three pillars of Lent, almsgiving is as the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches: "a witness to fraternal charity" and "a work of justice pleasing to God." During Lent, we are asked to focus more intently on almsgiving by donating to


the poor and performing acts of charity. St. John Chrysostom wrote, "Not to share our riches with the poor is a robbery of the poor, and a depriving them of their livelihood. It is for this that God has permitted you to possess much that you should distribute it to the needy."

To live out almsgiving in the spirit of Lenten sacrifice and following the clear teaching of Jesus, we do not give simply from our surplus or just what we can spare. Rather, we should give sacrificially. Giving alms to those in need is not just a good idea or a pious practice. It is truly a moral obligation. Acts of almsgiving during Lent allow us to:

- Let go of our own desires and focus on the needs of the less fortunate
- Sacrifice our temporal comfort for the good of another person
- Rely on God to meet our needs rather than providing for ourselves

Two of the central lessons of the cross are compassion and selflessness. As we go through this Lenten season, the world continues to suffer from pain and unrest. Now, more than ever, acts of almsgiving can bring us together and heal our wounds. You can never go wrong with generosity.

During this week, I invite you to be generous. God is defined by his generous giving — even his very self. In his Lenten message of 2020, Pope Francis wrote, "there is a need to appeal to men and women of goodwill to share, by almsgiving, their goods with those most in need, as a means of personally participating in the building of a better world. Charitable giving makes us more human, whereas hoarding risks making us less human, imprisoned by our own selfishness."





Twice a month, starting on March 10, your children will have the opportunity to join other children in a special Children's Liturgy. Children


will listen to the readings of the day in an interactive, child-friendly way so they can better understand God's Word and strengthen their faith. CLOW details:






### Lenten Scripture Study on Fridays of Lent Jeannette Holmes
