

TO LIVE AND TO LOVE IN CHRIST

TO HEAR THE GOSPEL AND MAKE A DIFFERENCE



Dear Friends,

Christmas Day may be Dec. 25, but it's not the end of the Christmas story. In our Christian traditions, there are 12 days of Christmas, culminating around Jan. 6, known as the feast of the Epiphany. That's when many believe the "Magi" or "wise men" or "three kings" arrive to see the newborn baby Jesus.





The word "Epiphany" and the events recorded in Matthew's Gospel have come to mean a manifestation or a showing forth of the Christ-child to the nations. It reveals how God enlightens the hearts of all people and how he helps them to discover Him.

For generations, these wise men represent the whole of humanity whose thirst for truth propels them forward and is at the beginning of every religious quest. They are symbolic of the pull, the fascination being exerted on

them by God's objective truth and unfolding plan. In the words of Pope Benedict XVI, "These figures are forerunners, preparers of the way, seekers after truth, such as we find in every age. . . . They represent the inner aspiration of the human spirit, the dynamism of religions and human reason toward Christ."


The feast of the three Kings makes us aware of the primary "mover" in the story, God. He is not specifically mentioned, but the presence is obvious. The "star" had guided the wise men to Bethlehem. The prophecy had recorded exactly where the Messiah should be born, and the dream warned them to return home a different way. Without this divine intervention they would never have come, the scribes would not have known where to send them if they had arrived, and they would certainly have fallen into Herod's trap without the warning. The supernatural element moving in the lives of the Magi is the true cause of their actions.

But the critical word to define in this story is the word **worship**. They came to worship Jesus. And after they received confirmation from the Bible and from the Star, they knew this was of God, and so they came and worshiped him. The evidence of their worship came in the gifts they gave, gifts fit for a divine king.

You might also want to consider why gold, and incense, and myrrh were brought to Jesus by the Magi. Biblical commentaries often see symbolic meanings in the specific gifts; they say that gold was a gift for a king (but in the Old Testament gold was also the proper setting for the sanctuary where God dwelt among His people), the incense was for deity (as the sacrifices in the Old Testament were sprinkled with it), and the myrrh was a preparation for His suffering.

The feast of Epiphany is filled with meaning at so many levels. What strikes me at the core is the fact that the Kings left their politics and ideologies behind in search of Truth. They allowed themselves to be led by a star, the God of all truth. A political snare awaited them in Herod who tried to woo them into falsehood. But their eyes were set on the star, the light that comes from above.

Brian McLaren said, "People can't see what they can't see. Their biases get in the way, surrounding them like a high wall, trapping them in ignorance, deception and illusion." May the Star that illumined the pathway for the Wise Kings lead us to all Truth.
