

TO LIVE AND TO LOVE IN CHRIST

TO HEAR THE GOSPEL AND MAKE A DIFFERENCE



Dear Friends,

The Third Sunday in Advent shifts from a tone of expectation of Christ's coming to one of rejoicing at the arrival of God's kingdom with the coming of Jesus. The theme for the Third Sunday of Advent is Joy.

On the Third Sunday of Advent, we light the candle that represents JOY – Joy that comes through Jesus's arrival and through the salvation he has gifted us. The rose candle has

its roots in something known as Gaudete Sunday. The word "gaudete" is derived from the Latin words "gaudium," joy, and "gaudeo," to rejoice or be glad. Gaudete Sunday occurs eight to thirteen days before Christmas, and the nearness of the feast is reason for great joy.



The Term "Gaudete." Gaudete is taken from the Entrance Antiphon: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near" (paraphrase, Phil 4:4-5). Advent is a time of joyful expectation and eager preparation for the Solemnity of Christmas.

But perhaps some of you don't feel like rejoicing. Perhaps your own mood is more like the rest of Advent, darker, more anxious, somewhat unsettled, for any number of reasons, not least of which might be the state of the world.

The news of the world is always a distressed word, a word full of sadness and anger, a word tinged with fear and heavy

with regret. Perhaps that is why the darker mood of the Advent season speaks to us at times more authentically than its more joyous mood.


Whether we recognize it or not we come to church to hear a counter-Word. We come burdened by our occupations and pre-occupations, weighed down by both the demands of daily living and the larger societal and global worries that clamor for our attention. We often think we have things pretty much figured out, but there are nagging areas of uncertainty about our fate and future.

To the ears of the world the Good News often sounds like too-good-to be-true news. And a weekly hour's religious interlude away from the world's worries may not be enough to get us ready for rejoicing. Nevertheless, on this Third Sunday in Advent we are admonished to rejoice. And you can only find that in the Savior of the world. If you are unable to set your heart on this Good News, who is JESUS, then the world will always remain dark, and your lives will always be nagged by an unsettling anxiety about what you have and what you don't have, and a desire for more.

The Christian story is above all a love story. It is not about something called religion, but it is all about the love God has for us. God wants us for himself. He wants us as lovers. This is the God who heals and saves, the God who gives meaning and hope to the downcast and new life to the dead. This is God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ and our Father, the God worth waiting for, and working for, and praying to and rejoicing with.

Advent is the Church's way of observing and remembering, of marking the truth we believe that **God is love**, and we are called to love. Let us remember to love!

LOVE is patient, LOVE is kind and envies no one. LOVE is never boastful or conceited, rude or selfish. LOVE is not quick to take offense, it keeps no records of wrongs, it does not gloat over other people's troubles, but rejoices in the right, the good, and the true. There is nothing that LOVE cannot face, there is no limit to its faith, to its hope, to its endurance. LOVE never ends.





End of the Year To Do's Required Minimum Distribution

If you have an IRA, SIMPLE IRA, SEP IRA, or retirement plan account and are over the age of 72 (73 if you reached age 72 after

Dec. 31, 2022), you are faced with a required minimum distribution (RMD) by the IRS. Your RMD is the minimum amount you must withdraw from your account each year to avoid significant tax penalties. The IRS has a qualified charitable donation rule that allows you to exempt your distribution from taxes. The significant advantage of this is that it lowers your adjusted gross income. The donation must be paid directly from the plan to the charity and the donor must be over 72. If you are in this situation, check with your tax advisor to see if it makes sense for you to apply this IRS rule and direct your RMD to Christ the King - St. Stephen Parish.


