

Dear Friends.

Our parish has been offering Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) for many years. During the pandemic (or prior to the pandemic) the program was dropped. I am happy to state that starting the second week of Lent, February 25th we will be restarting the program with a new set of teachers and volunteers. Heidi Nuti, from one of our active families at the parish and school will head the program with volunteers. I am so grateful to the many parishioners who signed up to help with CLOW.

The presider at the Mass invites the children to step forward towards the sanctuary after the opening prayer. He addresses them, and sends them with a blessing. Then, the CLOW leaders take the children to a special space prepared for them.

These sessions are not faith formation classes, arts-and-crafts activities, or babysitting during Mass. Rather, the children hear the same scripture readings as adults – but at their own age level. One benefit of CLOW is that, even when faith formation sessions end for the year, catechesis can continue during summer months.

The children return to the church and rejoin their families after the Prayers of the Faithful. One of the past teachers shared with me, "When I lead CLOW, I am

amazed at the openness, the love, and the questions that the children bring, I absolutely adore sharing the word of God with children, and I especially like when the children pray for their family and friends."


## **Liturgical Changes Beginning Ash Wednesday:**

Bishop Barber has made the following changes in the Liturgy starting Ash Wednesday. For those who do not receive the Staying Connected Newsletter every week, I can make the Bishop's long letter available to you if you call the parish office. In obedience to our bishop, we shall be implementing these changes starting Ash Wednesday. I have already heard from some of you as to how you feel. I thank you for your honesty and willingness to share your sentiments.

- 1. All parishes are to follow a two-year program for youth preparing for Confirmation.
- 2. Confirmation and Baptism Sponsors should be practicing Catholics in good standing with the Church. The Bishop wrote to us priests, "For sponsors coming from outside your parish, there is a form you may give them to have signed by their own pastor attesting they are practicing and in good standing."
- 3. The Bishop has asked us to cease offering Communion Services in the parishes in the place of the Mass. Communion services to the sick may continue.
- 4. Only a priest or deacon with faculties may preach the homily following the Gospel at Mass. Non-ordained persons may be invited to speak following the communion prayer.
- 5. To kneel after the Lamb of God in order to prepare ourselves reverently for reception of Holy Eucharist. After reception of Holy Communion, each person may choose to stand, sit or kneel as they choose.

We have been celebrating the Novena to Our Lady of Perpetual Help with music at the 9.00am mass on Thursdays. Mary has blessed our community in so many ways especially during the pandemic. I would like to invite all those who can attend the Thursday Mass to come and participate. It would be so amazing to have a church full of Marian devotees. Don Bosco whose feast we celebrate on January 31<sup>st</sup> said: "Trust in Mary and you will know what miracles are!"

# BLACK HISTORY MONTH

There are many causes for celebrating the gifts of black Catholics today. One is simply the numbers that populate parishes across the country: the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops estimates that there are 3 million black Catholics in the U.S., and 798 predominantly African American parishes. While many black people are Baptist, the second largest religious group that black people belong to in the U.S. is the Catholic Church. There are 250 African American priests, 437 deacons, 75 men of African descent in seminary formation, 400 African American religious sisters, and 50 religious brothers. These numbers do not include missionaries from Africa who now serve in various ministries throughout the United States. Another cause for celebration is the inspiring list of black men and women whose causes for canonization are being advanced.

The historically black Xavier University of Louisiana (founded by Saint Katharine Drexel) announced that its Institute of Black Catholic Studies (IBCS) would support efforts toward the canonization of five black Catholics.




On February 5th, we remember the 5 year death anniversary of Fr. Brian Joyce.

An excerpt from one of his 4 minute homilies on November 4, 2001:

But have you noticed we Catholics still pray for the dead – why is that – I don't think it's really to get our loved ones an early pardon from purgatory or to help them escape from a divine "lock up."

- -Praying for the dead is a Catholic way of saying that their life goes on;
- -Praying for the dead witnesses to a communion and solidarity that we continue to gently hold on to one another even after death by faith and by prayer;
- -Praying for the dead is both a human and Christian way of saying "we do not forget," "we will not forget;" -And, finally if our day to day experience of life is any indication, whether before or after death, there is constant change, growth, ongoing dynamic blossoming so we pray that our loved ones may continue to grow and to advance in bliss and in joy until one day, with their rough edges gone and our rough edges made smooth, we will all meet again!






