Dear Fellow Parishioners,


Our pre-registration process for Religious Education continues, and we have registered 82 children thus far. Twenty-five (25) of the children registered will be enrolled in classes for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.

We are still evaluating whether classes will be offered on Sunday and will let you know when we get more children registered. If you have friends who have not yet registered their children, please encourage them to do so now. We need to know any children will be enrolled to order textbooks, enlist the correct number of catechists and reserve the correct amount of space for the classes.

We also continue to encourage you to enroll your children in grades 3 through 8. These formative years, between the sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation, are a critical time for children to learn more about their faith. In studying mathematics, children can't move from arithmetic to advanced calculus without many years of study in between. The same goes with their faith. Ongoing formation is essential for children to learn and practice their faith. Please allow CTK RE to be your partner in the faith formation of your children. We are here to serve and support you in your efforts to raise your children in the faith.

Finally, we continue to ask all parents to consider becoming catechists. There is no better way to better learn your faith than teaching it. Your example of engagement by teaching the faith will also be a great witness of your faith to your children.
