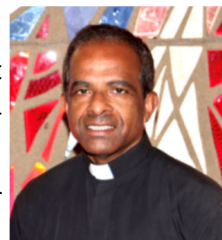

Dear Friends,

I am happy to inform you that we are very close to getting our parking lot repaved this summer.

We have approval from the Diocese to proceed with the repaving of the blacktopped areas that we currently use for parking for the rectory, church, ministry center and school. Our bidding process is complete, and we have notified the low bidder that they will be awarded the contract. Civil plans are being developed for submission to the City of Pleasant Hill for verification of our striping and handicapped parking plans. The goal is to start the work as soon as the city grants permission to proceed. In doing this work, the existing asphalt will be removed and recycled in place. Our goal is to start the work on a Monday in the small parking lot near the rectory to remove the asphalt, re-compact the sub-base gravel, and repave the area. The plan is to have all lots repaved within a week and all work completed before school starts in the fall. Thank you in advance for your patience!



There are two other options for safety and convenience that we plan to pursue with the city later this year. One is to add a new entrance to the main lot on Gregory Lane using an existing driveway to the east of the main entrance to the lot. This will allow east bound traffic to enter the lot without interfering with west bound traffic which must now wait, blocking a lane on Gregory, while cars enter at the single-entry driveway. The second option is to add a connection between the two separate lots along Gregory so overflow cars that enter the smaller lot near the church will not have to exit onto Gregory to re-enter the larger lot to the west. Right now, we will only proceed with the repaving of the current blacktopped areas. I will continue to keep you updated.

Financing. There's good news and less good news on our financing for the project. The good news is that bids we received were lower than our initial estimates. As a result, we have dropped our target for fund raising from \$1.5 million to \$1 million. The less good news is that we have secured only 25% of the total we need to fully fund the project. We plan to keep the project moving this summer, and dip into our savings as needed to make up the difference. However, we will need to rebuild our savings as a result and we must rely on you, our parishioners, to help with this funding.

As of now, we have pledges or donations to the project that total roughly \$125,000 from just 158 parishioners. If you do the math that's an average of around \$33 per month over two years. Christ the King School will also assist us in this effort. My sincerest thanks to those of you who have donated to this project!

For those of you who have not donated yet, please consider making a pledge over the next two years. We see roughly 3,000 people at mass every week, not to mention weddings and funerals, and our parking lots get plenty of use. Every dollar you donate will go to making these parking lots safe and available to our parish community for the long term. Any amount you can donate is welcome and most appreciated.

3. One-time donations are also welcome, and checks can be dropped in the collection basket. Just note on your check "Paving Project".

Christ the King Parishioners have a long history of stepping up and contributing to the projects that sustain us now and for the future. We understand if your financial circumstances do not allow you to support this effort now, but if you can find a way to donate or make a pledge it would be greatly appreciated.

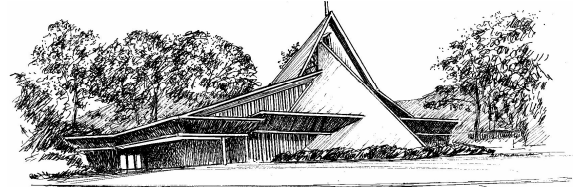

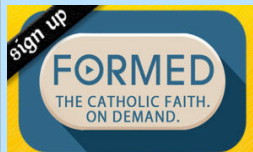
