“TO HEAR THE GOSPEL AND MAKE A DIFFERENCE.”

Dear Friends,

The month of May is here. It is a month dedicated to our Blessed Mother Mary. The pious practice of honoring Mary during May has been especially promoted by the popes. Pius XII made frequent reference to this devotion; one example can be found in his great Encyclical on the Sacred Liturgy, *Mediator Dei*. He characterized it as an “exercise of piety which although not strictly belonging to the Sacred Liturgy ... nevertheless (is) of special import and dignity.”



Devotion to Mary is an important part of our Catholic identity. Our school children will celebrate Mass this Friday at 8.00am with the May Crowning, a beautiful tradition honoring Mary. At its simplest, the May Crowning is a ritual celebrated in May where a statue of Mary is crowned with a wreath of flowers - to honor Mary as Queen of Heaven and Mother of God. This simple ceremony carries deep meaning within our Catholic faith. While Mary, the Mother of God is revered and celebrated all year long, May is a special month to celebrate the “Queen of Heaven.”



On May 25th, Thursday, we as a community will be honoring Mary by celebrating an “International Rosary” at Christ the King Campus. One Church. One common prayer. The International Rosary is a World Languages Prayer Service and a beautiful celebration of the universality of Catholicism. The Hail Mary prayers of the first 4 decades of the rosary are initiated in different languages and concluded in English. The 5th decade is prayed entirely in English. The service will begin immediately after our 6pm

Mass – honoring Our Mother of Perpetual Help. And we shall pray the Luminous Mysteries, with hymns and commentaries.

Our Adult Faith Formation Committee will be sponsoring this devotion. If you speak one or multiple languages other than English, please call the parish office or email the office at office@ctkph.org. We will get in touch with you and let you know the process.

Recently Dr. Terrence Heywood came to the rectory and helped Fr. Brian and me in updating our Advanced Medical Directives. We then uploaded it to Kaiser website. Today, if I go to the hospital, they have all the information they need. Everyone involved in a patient’s care should understand how a person’s history and cultural and religious background may influence expectations, needs, and choices at the end of life. The natural law and the Fifth Commandment require that all ordinary means be used to preserve life, such as food, water, exercise, and medical care. The following will be addressed at this meeting:

Preparing for one’s funeral – Forms supplied – Sr. Dominic








**Praying The Rosary
