HIROSHIMA AND NAGASAKI WEEKEND OF REMEMBRANCE AUGUST 6-7 This weekend, global vigils are being held to commemorate the bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki at the end of World War II. It is a time to console the victims and their families and to pray for peace and an end to the use of nuclear weapons. Here in Seattle, a lantern ceremony is to be held on the evening of Saturday, August 6 at Green Lake. On Monday, there will be a vigil and a call for nonviolence at the Bangor submarine base, which houses one of the largest arsenals of nuclear weapons in the world. Please pray for an end to violence and for the flourishing of God's peace.


