SWOT Analysis

Introduction

Two SWOT events were held, one for the congregation at large and the other for the ILC staff. The following analysis is based upon the collective information gathered. Of note, responses at both events revealed significant commonness of perception among the participants, numbering approximately forty individuals. Strengths and Weaknesses are internally focused. Opportunities and Threats are externally focused.

Island Lutheran Ministry Model Multi-site Ministry Model

Led by the Holy Spirit, Island Lutheran Church will seek to establish ministry sites within the Savannah, Beaufort, and Hilton Head Island region, as well as online- reaching people around the world.

The ministry sites may be unique in their location (e.g., commercial or industrial space, school gymnasium, or church building). Ministry sites may vary in the work that takes place in and through them (e.g., school, care center, business, etc.).

Ministry sites will have common qualities:

- The Island Lutheran Church ministry DNA, namely a focus upon Discipleship, Family, and Community.
- The Core Values: Scripture Alone, Discipleship, Generosity, and Serving.

The Multi-site Ministry Model functions with shared resources (financial, volunteers, staffing, and physical supplies) within a single governance structure.

The Multi-site Ministry Model, based upon prayerful discussions, celebrates the opportunity for ministry sites to transition into independent congregations.



Island Lutheran Church Foundation Buckets

October 2024

Board Designated- Gifts given with the understanding the Board will determine distribution based upon Board determination of needs. This bucket is also the default bucket for all "non-designated" gifts.

Campus Care- The "bricks and mortar" bucket; gifts designated for Campus Care are available to address needs such as deferred maintenance, campus development, unexpected campus expenses, etc.

Education- Monies available to support educational ministries beyond the budget. Examples include scholarships, leadership training, sabbaticals, student loan forgiveness, etc.

Ministry Expansion- Monies available to support ministry expansion associated with adopted congregational vision and plans (outside annual budget). At the present time, Ministry Expansion for our ILC family is focused upon Mainland and Online ministries. Over time, Ministry Expansion may evolve into other areas of focus.

Missions- Monies available for ILC Mission Partners (e.g., Lutheran Church Charities, India Transformed, Southeastern District of the LCMS, Capstone Ministries, etc.)

Pass Through- Monies available for non-profit entities identified as community, national, or international partners with ILC. The beneficiary of these gifts is determined in conversation between the benefactor and ILC leadership. Examples may include Neighborhood Outreach Connection (NOC), Volunteers in Medicine (VIM), etc.
