**OVERVIEW OF ISOA GLOBAL IMPACT AWARDS**

Every year, the ISOA Global Impact Awards Program recognizes the superlative performance of our ISOA member companies, providing inspiration to our entire stability operations community. ISOA celebrates those extraordinary efforts through our annual **Global Impact Awards** program.

We recognize that 2025 has been a particularly challenging year for many of our members due to unprecedented changes in U.S. Government contracting. Therefore, this year’s program focuses on two categories that highlight the effectiveness, flexibility, and resilience of our member companies:

- **Vanguard Award:** Recognizing companies that demonstrate excellence in supporting stability operations through leadership, strong performance, and unwavering commitment to mission success.
- **Innovation Award:** Recognizing companies that deliver groundbreaking solutions or approaches in challenging environments, demonstrating creativity and measurable impact.

We encourage all member companies to nominate themselves for their exemplary work in stability operations over the past several years. Our independent panel of judges will select four (4) Award winners in each category, based on company size to ensure fairness, for a total of eight (8) company awards. ISOA will also present two Lifetime Achievement Awards—one to a government official and one to a private sector leader.

**Award Tiers (by Company Size)**

Companies will be evaluated by gross annual revenue:

- Greater than \$500 million (ISOA Tier 1+ and Tier 1)
- \$20.1 million - \$500 million (ISOA Tiers 2, 3 & 4)
- \$3.1 million - \$20 million (ISOA Tier 5)
- Less than \$3 million (ISOA Tier 6)

We look forward to receiving your Awards nominations. Please follow the precise instructions in this nomination packet to be considered for an award.

The deadline for all nominations is Friday, August 29, 2025, at midnight Eastern Daylight Time. Awards will be presented at the Global Impact Awards Luncheon on Wednesday, November 5 during ISOA’s Global Summit in Washington, D.C.

**GLOBAL IMPACT AWARDS NOMINATION GUIDELINES**

Please use the following guidelines for your submissions:

- For your submissions, please limit your entire response to the questions below to a TOTAL of no more than three pages (Parts II and III below) PLUS your cover page with basic company information. Include the full text of the Award category (listed below) in your response. Please do not customize the three pages to create a separate entry for each category. Use Times New Roman font, in 11 pitch, single-spaced, with normal page margins. **Provide text only – please do not submit any images, pictures, photos, or graphics of any sort.**
- Each of your Award submissions are to be based on your company’s work over the past two years, from June 2023-June 2025. Please do not use examples from a previous ISOA Award submission.
- Each company is limited to receiving an Award in one category only, although companies may submit their nomination in both categories if they choose. Your three-page nomination may be submitted in both categories, but please do not customize your three-page submission to create an entry for each category.
- ISOA recommends focusing your nomination on one category but reserves the right to give the award in the other category.
- Your Award nominations are limited to your own company. You may not nominate another company for an Award.
- To be considered for an Award, your company must be an approved member of ISOA by August 29, 2025.

- Your Award nomination will be reviewed by an independent, unbiased, four-judge panel. After your submission is received, all references to your company name and identity will be redacted so that the judges will review and adjudicate your nomination purely on the merits of your submission.
- ISOA will maintain the confidentiality of any information in your nomination packet that is identified as such. Please note, however, if your nomination wins an award, you will be asked to provide a description of your award project that can be used for promotional purposes.

**PREPARING YOUR NOMINATION**

**ALL AWARDS SUBMISSIONS SHOULD INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING PARTS:**

**PART I: Cover Page with Company Basic Information**

This is a separate cover page with basic company information: your company name; your company's ISOA Tier level; your company's current gross annual revenue; the name and email address of your company point of contact (POC) for the award submission; and your company's headquarters location.

**Part II: Company overview and an example of commitment to our Code of Conduct**

- 2) A brief background/summary of your company to include the countries where your company operates, core competencies, corporate initiatives undertaken that serve to develop, align, and support these core competencies, and any other helpful background information.
- 3) Because transparency, accountability, ethical conduct, and respect for human rights are hallmarks of our ISOA member companies and communities, please provide one example from over the past two years in which your company demonstrated a commitment to these time-tested attributes. Share any challenges or adversities you faced.

**PART III: Description of your achievements in a category selected from the list below. Please note that all qualifying nominations should include the following:**

- Examples from the last two years
- Countries or regions of program implementation
- A concise description of how your organization's program was executed
- Type of contract or grant vehicle utilized
- Key project challenges overcome during project implementation
- Most noteworthy project performance

**AWARD CATEGORIES INCLUDE:**

***VANGUARD AWARD***

- Provide examples over the past two years that demonstrate your organization's most significant achievements/efforts in stability operations, contingency operations, disaster recovery operations, or humanitarian assistance. Include the specific program, country, and program or activity goals as well as specific accomplishments and results.

***INNOVATION AWARD***

- To survive and thrive in today’s government contracting business environment, organizations must continually adapt, creating new techniques and processes to solve current challenges, address new requirements to support U.S. national security, and/or address new markets.
- Describe your activities and efforts to innovate or adapt with a new or more technologically advanced approach to a challenge our industries currently face.
- Demonstrate how this innovation improved your company’s or program’s efficiency, effectiveness, and overall performance.
- This innovation can be through a value-added service, product, or approach of any dimension.

**SUBMITTING YOUR AWARD NOMINATION**

- ISOA recommends focusing your nomination on one category but reserves the right to present the award in the other category if appropriate.
