Style UNCorked donates Apparel to Family Crisis Shelter

A Williston women's apparel business has teamed up with its customers to give new and slightly used clothing to the Family Crisis Shelter.

Style UNCorked Boutique, located at 125 Main Street Suite C in Downtown Williston; held a Denim Drive in late August to raise awareness and jeans for the

shelter. The store rewarded customers who donated their lightly used jeans with in-store discounts off of the purchase of

new jeans. Style UNCorked donated several boxes of denim and selected new clothing to the Family Crisis Shelter on Monday, Oct. 23.

"We know how important the Family Crisis Shelter is to our community and a lot of their clients don't have anything," said Style UNCorked co-owner Deanette Piesik.

The Family Crisis Shelter has been in Williston for nearly 40 years. Julia Kourajian Bush and Lynn Hannig accepted the donation on behalf of the shelter. The pair were on a break from moving.

"We are so grateful for this donation," said Kourajian Bush.

The shelter, which offers round the clock crisis intervention for the victims of domestic violence and sexual assault, is relocating to a new, larger space. They are optimistic the move could be completed by early to mid-November.

Meanwhile, Style UNCorked plans to offer other philanthropic events in the future.

"We will give back to the community with our *Shop for a Cause* events," said Wenko.

During *Shop for a Cause*, Style UNCorked will designate a portion of its sales to a pre-selected charity. The store will also offer fun shopping events for friends, families and co-workers; just in time for the holiday season!

"We are scheduling girls' nights (private shopping parties) where ladies can shop in the store with their friends. Anyone can contact us to have a party," said Wenko.

Style UNCorked is located in the Renaissance on Main building in Downtown Williston. The boutique is open Monday through Saturday from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Thursdays from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.
