

North Dakota Downtown Impact Awards

The 2019 North Dakota Downtown Conference is proud to introduce the inaugural North Dakota Downtown Awards! The awards have been created to highlight wonderful efforts being made in Downtown Districts throughout our great communities. Up to six awards will be given at the North Dakota Downtown Conference Awards Luncheon on Thursday, August 29. Nominations must be received by August 16.

Categories are:

Downtown Leadership - The nominee is an individual in a leadership role (city government, downtown organization, CVB's, Chambers, economic development, etc.). They have led the charge to improve their downtown district in a creative and impactful way.

Downtown Champion - The nominee volunteers their time/resources to improve downtown districts. The nominee is a valuable resource to the downtown district. This could be a volunteer, involved business owner or employee, community member or service organization.

Downtown Event - Any events that occur in a downtown district are eligible to be nominated. The nomination should explain the purpose and outcome of the event. Include marketing efforts, event details, etc. Two categories will be considered, based on Community Population - Over 10,000 and under 10,000.

Downtown Atmosphere - Any project that has improved the atmosphere and quality of the downtown district. Examples include art projects, bike share, Seasonal décor, etc. The nomination should explain how the project was implemented and how it has impacted the downtown district.
