THE COMPETITION

This section includes general information about the Corporate Cup.

Please note the competition details as it defines who may represent your company, and mark your calendar for Friday, May 28 as the deadline for submitting your team entry form unless the event sells out sooner.

The purpose of the Williston Corporate Cup is to promote community-wide interest and involvement in fitness and health activities and to help companies promote wellness within the workplace. The Corporate Cup event will be a whole day engagement beginning at 9:00 AM and ending at 5:00 PM. General rules and eligibility requirements are provided below.

All Chamber member businesses are eligible to participate in the Corporate Cup.

Teams will be comprised of up to 12 participants; with a minimum of 8 participants. Two or more member businesses can combine to create one competing team. It is at the discretion of individual teams, which teammates will compete in each event. The team roster will be due by June 4 at 5PM.

Corporate Cup participants must be at least 18 years of age to enter. Teams must be comprised of at least 50% full time or part time employees. The remaining percentage of team members can be volunteers, board members, family members of staff, or retirees of each company or organization at the time of competition. The team/organization will appoint a team captain to represent them at meetings and stand in as the official point of contact for matters regarding the Corporate Cup.

Each team can provide a volunteer (not required) this individual does not count toward the 12-team member maximum. Teams who provide one to two additional volunteers will be awarded an extra 100 points. Teams who provide three or more additional volunteers will be awarded an extra 200 points. For scheduling purposes, volunteers will not be able to participate in events and do not need to be employed by your organization. Teams whose registered volunteer does not show up to the event will be deducted 500 points. Additional volunteers that do not show up or leave early will result in a 150-point deduction per absent volunteer. Volunteers must be available from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. the day of the event. Part-time shifts or split shifts are available upon request.

Companies/Organizations with under 100 employees, in the Williston Area, may only enter one team.

Companies/Organizations with more than 100 employees, in the Williston Area, may enter up to two teams. All team members must be listed on the team roster due on June 4th. Any changes made to the submitted team roster prior to June 18th may result in forfeiture. Registered team members can represent only one team. Although each company of over 100 employees can field multiple teams; a separate registration must be completed for each team.

There are two event divisions in which to compete; the Athletic Division & the Skill Division. The points awarded in both divisions will be combined to determine your final placement in the Corporate Cup. The events in the Athletic Division will employ a higher point system, while the points awarded in the Skill Division events will attract comparably lower points. All points earned will go towards the final overall score for each team to determine the Corporate Cup Champion.

Teams are subject to forfeiture of an event and a 500-point deduction from their total score if they enter a person who is not on the official entry form or does not meet the employee eligibility rules. In the event of a participant challenge, both the employee and a company official must be prepared to confirm identification. We will rely on our team captains and the honor system to ensure that everyone is competing fairly!

Any team that registers and does not show, or leaves the competition early without prior notice will not be allowed to compete in the 2022 Corporate Cup.

The Corporate Cup is intended to provide fun, fair competition. Unsportsmanlike conduct could result in the removal of an individual or team.

Teams will be encouraged to stay 6 feet away from other teams. Equipment will be sanitized between each game. Participants will be asked to use hand sanitizer before entering their court/playing field. A majority of events are currently scheduled to take place outdoors, and all events may be moved indoors if needed.
