Duntz named City of Williston Communications Strategist

The City of Williston has hired Andrea Duntz as its first Communications Strategist. Duntz began her official duties on Monday, May 7, 2018.

The Communications Strategist is a new position designed to streamline the flow of information to the public and within the organization. The city currently employs about 300 people. Williston City Administrator David Tuan says Duntz will help create and implement a comprehensive communications plan.

"Our vision is to refine the way we communicate as a city by developing a communications plan, earning credibility and trust by establishing consistency, and improving the efficiency of services within our departments with innovation and technology," said Tuan.

Duntz, a Nebraska native, has traveled extensively to study, work and explore the world. Her career has taken her throughout Europe and across the United States. Most recently she has been the marketing and communications coordinator for a medical facility in Williston.

"Andrea was the top candidate following the city's intense search and selection process," said Tuan. "She brings with her excellent educational credentials and experience working in a multitude of professional environments."

Duntz will be meeting with department heads during her first few months. She says she looks forward to serving the community that inspired her to pick up and move to Williston last year.

"I'd been reading about Williston for years and last September I decided to move here and see it for myself. When I saw the city was looking for a Communications Strategist I felt like it was too good of an opportunity and too good of a fit for my skillset to pass up," said Duntz.
