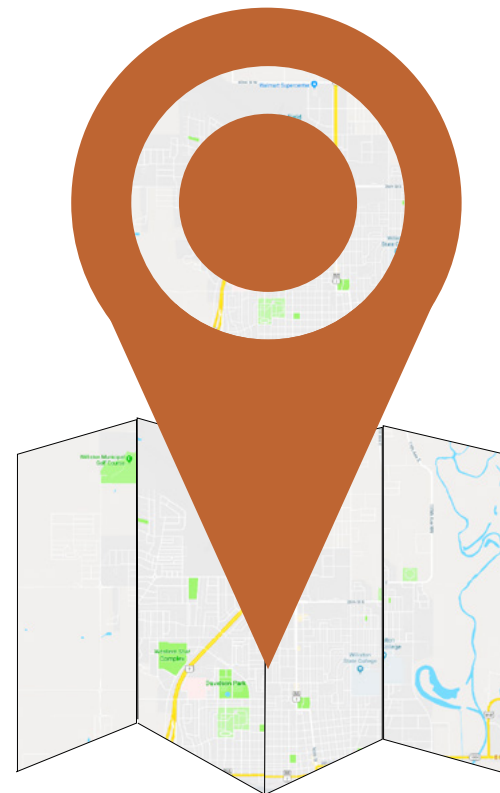
Renaissance on Main (ROM)
