### ***Is there public transportation near or around the home?***

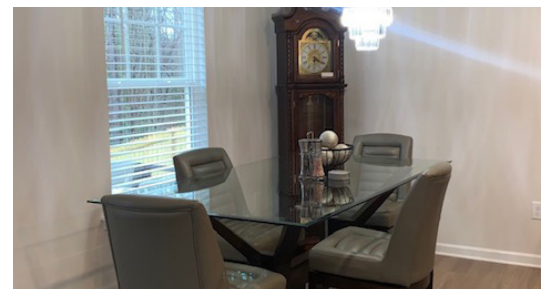

This is an unlicensed 5 bedroom home built in a new neighborhood. Several recreational activities around the home include a bowling alley, community park and pool. The home is wheelchair accessible with the individual's bedroom and bathroom on the bottom floor. There is only one step at the home entrance. Ms. Atkinson is able to transport a manual chair, but does not have an accessible vehicle to transport an electric wheelchair.
