POSITION SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Choir Director is responsible for all aspects of directing student vocal ensembles, ensuring they run smoothly and efficiently with the goal of enriching students' music education through collaboration in a vocal ensemble. Working closely with the school music educator, the Choir Director will be responsible for programming performances throughout the school year aligned to grade-level curriculum. The Choir Director will rehearse and direct ensembles at all performances, to include some evening performances.

The choir director interacts positively and diplomatically with a wide range of constituents including teachers, aides and staff within Lafayette Elementary, parents and caregivers. As the day-to-day lead educator for the vocal ensembles, the Choir Director will be expected to exercise excellent judgment and initiative, managing students in the classroom and handling matters independently.

SCHEDULE: Lafayette Elementary School employs a six-day rotating schedule. This position will report for instructional duty from 2:30 – 3:15pm on Days 1-4 for the SY 2017-2018. Additional class preparation time, administrative and grade-level team meetings to be scheduled as needed during the school year.

- Evidence of superior musicianship in classical stylistic interpretation.
- Evidence of good rehearsal and classroom management skills.
- Training/experience in motivating elementary students of all abilities and directing age appropriate music productions.
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to maintain a sense of perspective and humor.
