2019 AWARDS JURY

Dwayne R. Eshenbaugh, AIA, NCARB, LEED AP, is founder of NOVUS Architecture, an award-winning, 10-year-old, 10-person firm located in heart of downtown Las Vegas, Nevada. The firm provides architecture, interior design, planning, and sustainability services to an esteemed group of like-minded clients. Dwayne received his bachelor's degree from the UNLV School of Architecture and his master's degree from the University of Arizona where he was awarded the Daryl B. Dobras Award for outstanding graduate student. At NOVUS Architecture, Dwayne serves as the firm's Principal in Charge and Design Principal where he synthesizes his 25 years of leadership and experience into each unique project. Dwayne has generated a diverse body of work, ranging from small boutique hospitality projects to large scale higher education projects – and everything in between. The common thread of his work is the incessant and disciplined quest for design excellence. Dwayne is currently serving a three-year term as a jury member for the AIA Western Mountain Region Honor Awards and will conclude in 2021 as Jury Chair. Dwayne has served on the AIA Las Vegas Board of Directors for several years and is the 2019 Chapter President where he has engaged the 500-member Chapter and Community in his program, Blueprint for Better: Explorations into Affordable Housing and Homelessness. He was recently sworn in as 2020 AIA Nevada President and will focus on important issues for Nevada Architects in preparation for the 2021 Nevada Legislative Session. Dwayne is a 36-year resident of Las Vegas (originally from Pittsburgh, PA) and is a United States Air Force Veteran.



Marsha Maytum FAIA, LEED AP, is a founding Principal at Leddy Maytum Stacy Architects (LMSA) in San Francisco, winner of the 2017 National AIA Architecture Firm Award. For over 35 years Marsha has focused her career on community, cultural, and socially-responsible projects that promote sustainable design. Her work has included the creation of new buildings, rehabilitation of historic buildings, and adaptive reuse of existing structures. LMSA has received over 175 regional, national and international design awards and has been

recognized by organizations including the American Institute of Architects, Urban Land Institute, National Trust for Historic Preservation, U.S. Department of Energy, U.S. Green Building Council, and the 2014 ICC National Leadership in Sustainability Award. Ten of the firm's projects have been named AIA COTE Top Ten green projects in the U.S. Marsha is a frequently invited juror and critic and has lectured nationally on the topics of sustainable design and adaptive reuse. She is the 2019 Chair of the National AIA Committee on the Environment Advisory Group and has been the Pietro Belluschi Visiting Professor at the University of Oregon, the Howard A. Friedman Visiting Professor at the University of California, Berkeley and a visiting professor at the California College of the Arts.



Paul Haack, AIA, is a Principal at Anderson Mason Dale Architects, a Denver-based nationally recognized and award-winning firm and the 2017 American Institute of Architects (AIA) Colorado Firm of the Year. Paul has more than 35 years of experience, joining Anderson Mason Dale in 1987, becoming a Partner in 1993 and named President of the firm in 2007. Paul has extensive experience in higher education sector and has designed more than 30 projects on a dozen campuses in the Rocky Mountain West. He has the firm's deepest experience in campus planning and in the design of the firm's higher education projects. His work has been recognized by multiple organizations including the 2017 Laboratory of the Year, R&D Laboratory Design Special Recognition for Collaborative Learning Environment for the University of Wyoming's Enzi (STEM) Educational Facility. In addition to his design portfolio and years of mentorship, Paul served for six years as the Director of the AIA Denver chapter, was on the Lower Downtown Denver Design Review Board, has served as a Juror for multiple AIA chapters and serves regularly on juries at the University of Colorado Denver. His recent presentations include at the 2019 SCUP Annual Conference in Seattle, Designing for Introverts; 2018 ACUHO-I Conference & Expo in Denver, Wellness and the High Achieving Students.
