### **Allied Health-Medical Terminology**

ALLH 101 • Wednesdays 9:00 am-10:50 am • Aug. 22 - Dec. 13, 2018

This course is designed to introduce students to the fundamentals of medical terminology, including basic medical/surgical terms parts of the body, medical specialties, and medical abbreviations.

## College Algebra

MATH 143 • Tuesdays & Thursdays 11:30 am-12:50 pm • Aug. 21-Dec. 13, 2018

This course includes fundamental concepts of algebra. Credit hours are not granted in both MATH 143 and MATH 147. Prerequisite: MATH 043 with a grade of "C" or higher, or CSI placement test score. This course meets General Education Core requirements.

### **Elementary Spanish 1**

**SPAN 101 • Tuesdays & Thursdays 10:00 am-10:50 am • Aug. 21 - Dec. 13, 2018** 

The focus in this class is on using Spanish to exchange real-life information and ideas, and on the functional grammar and vocabulary to accomplish this. Beginners and students with fewer than two years of high school Spanish should register for this course. This course meets General Education Core requirements.

## **English Composition**

ENGL 100/101 • Tuesdays & Thursdays 1:00 pm-3:20 pm • Aug. 20 - Dec. 13, 2018

Students write analytical essays based on readings, observations, and ideas: develop various strategies to respond to different rhetorical situations; and edit for style, voice, and conventions of standard usage. This course introduces MLA format. Prerequisite: Satisfactory placement score. This course meets General Education Core requirements.
