## Foundation Year in Review – 2022

**Generous Donations Supported Professional Development, Increased Expansion of NABE's Diversity and Outreach Efforts, and Continued Support of the Long-Term Success of the Certified Business Economist® (CBE) Program**

*The NABE Foundation* was founded in 2004 with the mission of providing professionals in the field of business economics with the information, tools, and development opportunities they need to succeed. In 2022, the generous contributions from NABE members allowed for the continued success of *The NABE Foundation* to meet and succeed at its core mission, and *The Foundation's* accomplishments in 2022 exceeded many of its previously established targets and allowed the organization to greatly expand its support of its many important initiatives.

- In 2022, the CBE program went back in person, and *The Foundation* was there, as always, to help fund early-career professionals in need. During 2022, more than **240** participants enrolled in NABE certificate courses or the CBE exam. *The Foundation* awarded CBE course scholarships or subsidies for the CBE Exam to **28 individuals**, and **63 young professionals** received scholarships to attend a NABE conference or seminar – a **23% increase** in total scholarships awarded from the previous year.
- *The Foundation* made a big investment in the future of economic education, funding a **Job Task Analysis Survey** to ensure the CBE program is meeting the needs of today's business economists and providing the tools and skills required of a successful practitioner. Thank you to all who took the time to give us your insights.
- *The Foundation's* annual Economic Measurement Seminar had **more than 200** registrations, including 75 virtual attendees.
- *The Foundation* awarded nearly **\$100,000** in awards and scholarship assistance last year, with more than **\$22,000** in support of those taking CBE courses and more than **\$50,000** to support the 2022-23 NABE Scholars, thanks to the generous members of the Scholars' Circle of Benefactors.
- *The Foundation* funded the **2022 NABE Salary Survey**, the biennial look at compensation and job characteristics within the NABE community, and promoted the value of research through the **annual contributed papers awards**.

- *The Foundation* and the NABE organization continued to enhance its support of outreach to diverse individuals and organizations:
  - Expanded the NABE Scholars program by funding the attendance of 20 diverse economics students and early-career economists to four conferences, one CBE course of the Scholar's choosing, and a travel stipend. Thank you to our newly formed Scholars' Circle of Benefactors, which ensures that this program will continue to be funded.
  - Continued its support of the AEA's Summer Program for Minority Students in Economics through the sponsorship of a multidisciplinary economics career panel and luncheon and a social gathering at my home (with Kansas City-style barbecue!) for the participants of the 2022 summer program.
- We continue to be fortunate to have NABE leaders willing to make legacy donations. These meaningful donations provide lasting support for long-term, ongoing initiatives such as scholarship offerings and CBE program support.
- Support for *The NABE Foundation* comes in all sizes. In 2022, contributions came in from **119** unique donors.

## In Conclusion

I look forward to *The NABE Foundation* achieving many great things ahead this year, including *The Foundation's* support of scholarships for professionals attending our conferences and

pursuing their CBE. Foundation funds will also support the 20th year of the flagship Economic Measurement Seminar. NABE leaders will continue working on the CBE program research initiative that will ensure the program is best serving the needs of today's business economists, while also positioning it to meet future needs. And last but not least, *The Foundation* will continue its commitment to making the economics profession a more diverse and inclusive one.

As we look ahead to 2023 and beyond, we ask you to consider *The NABE Foundation* in your giving plans.
