


# What is the Southern California Association of Governments?

- 38k square miles


# SCAG region is younger than the U.S. but getting older




# SCAG region is richer than the U.S. with significant intra-regional variability



Real household income is higher and grew by more in Southern California than in the U.S.




# SCAG region has lower home ownership than California and the U.S.




# More SCAG households face housing affordability burden than households in the U.S.




