I am glad to circle back and provide some information that we hope those at Trinity Episcopal will be happy to learn.

The generosity of the year end gift of \$5000 could not have been better times or more appreciated as it was used to fund the purchase of food for our Fellowship Club "Lunch to Go" program.

Back in March of 2020 when we first closed our Fellowship Club program due to the COVID pandemic, we quickly determined that our lunch program was a critical resource to our members. Three days later we opened our patio for a safe and socially distanced food program. Our spacious outdoor patio has been utilized for maintaining a daily connection to our clients and a place to offer essentials like access to outdoor computer stations and phones. We even moved our onsite thrift store "the Care Closet" outdoors for access to a fresh set of socks and warm clothes. Over the last 14 months we have strengthened our partnerships with the Foodbank, Doctors Without Walls and homeless outreach providers to offer first aid check ups and vaccination clinics. We see 80-100 adults each day and have seen an increase of new people who are un-housed that came for the food and found other resources they needed.
