

Purcell Marian High School Walk

Cavalier Walk Day is Friday, September 22, 2017

Walk Info:

We will begin school at 7:45 am. Tardy Policy is in effect.

Students should report directly to their family room. The morning of the walk students will receive a PM walk map and their walk cards.

Students will be able to be out of uniform and should dress in spirit wear. Students should follow the rules for out of uniform found in our student handbook.

At 8:15 we will start dismissing families to begin the walk.

- Students must raise at least \$25 in order to participate in the walk.
- Any student who does not raise at least \$25 will stay at school to perform various tasks or study.

Students will follow the walk course and get their walk cards checked off at each station. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary consequences.

Once students complete the walk course, they will report back to the main entrance on Hackberry to turn in their walk cards. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action.

Once student have turned in their walk cards, they can get something to eat in the courtyard before being dismissed.

Depending on a walker's speed, students could be finished anywhere between 10:00 am – 11:00 am.

The Metro busses will be coming at normal times; if you need to take the Metro, you will be required to wait outside or in the cafeteria until the busses arrive.

Sponsor a student:

Students should ask family, church members, neighbors, etc. to sponsor them in the PM Walk. Sponsors can donate a lump sum, or give students a dollar amount per mile walked. The PM Walk is about 4 miles. All funds raised will go to support Student Life activities from Campus Ministry to Athletics.

Family Incentives:

Points – Families will receive 25 points for every family member who participates on Walk Day.

- If a family raises \$2,000 they will all be able to turn around at Station #3.
- If a family raises \$1,500 they will all be able to turn around at Station #4.

We will dismiss families to begin the walk by order of who brought in the most money. Families should exit out the main entrance on Hackberry, where each family will sing the fight song for 100 points.

Individual Incentives:

If an individual student brings in \$50, they will receive a coupon for a free t-shirt from the Spirit Shop.

If a student brings in \$100, they will receive a coupon for a free sweatshirt from the spirit shop.

School Incentives:

If the school raises a total of \$10,000, students will all receive a day off school.
