

Purcell Marian High School 2017 Homecoming Rules and Regulations

Must be signed to attend

- 1. All tickets are pre-sale.
 - a. Tickets will be sold during all lunch periods September 18th September 21st.
 - b. Tickets may be purchased for \$10.
 - c. Any non-Purcell Marian student attending as a guest must be approved by administration. As a guest, you, your parent and your school administrator must complete a Guest Form and turn it in to Ms. Winfrey or Mr. Tobin when you purchase the ticket. You will not be able to attend the dance if you do not comply. See the main office or Ms. Winfrey to receive a Guest Form. Guests older than 19 years old will not be permitted. Freshmen are not allowed to bring guests from another school.
 - d. The theme for this Homecoming is **Throwback**.
- 2. In order for a Purcell Marian student to buy a Homecoming Ticket, they and their parent must have read, signed, and turned in this form when they purchase their ticket(s).
- 3. Homecoming begins at 8:00 p.m. and ends at 11:00 p.m. All students must be present before 8:30 p.m. and no student may leave before 10:45 p.m. All students are required to arrange for transportation home. Non-compliance with this may result in students being restricted from attending future dances.
- 4. Appropriate dress is required for Homecoming. See the Student Handbook for appropriate dress code. Females should not wear dresses that expose an excessive amount of skin in the chest or stomach areas and the dresses should not be too short.
- 5. If there is any suspicion of use of alcohol or illegal drugs at Homecoming, parents will immediately be called and students will receive consequences by school administration.
- 6. Dancing must be appropriate. Inappropriate dancing could result in student being asked to leave the dance.
- 7. All students are reminded that Homecoming is a Purcell Marian function; therefore, all school rules and regulations, especially those regarding behavior and respect, are in effect.

Failure to comply with the above regulations and procedures may result in a student receiving school consequences from the administration.
