Rules and Regulations; Must be signed to Buy Ticket

1. All tickets are pre-sale.
 - a. Tickets will be sold during lunch from April 24th – April 28th.
 - b. Tickets for the dinner and dance are \$55 a piece or two for \$100.
 - c. Any non-Purcell Marian student attending as a guest must be approved by administration. As a guest, you, your parent and your school administrator must complete the Guest form and **turn it in to Ms. Winfrey or Mr. Tobin by April 26th**. Your guest will not be able to attend the dance if you do not comply. See the main office, Ms. Johnson, or Mr. Tobin/Ms. Winfrey to receive a Guest form.
2. In order for a Purcell Marian Student to buy a Prom Ticket, they and their parent must have read and signed this form and **turned it in when they but their ticket.**
3. Prom doors open at 7:00 p.m. and it ends at 11:00 pm. All students must be present before 7:30 pm. and no student can leave before 10:45 p.m. All students are required to arrange for transportation home.
4. Appropriate dress is required for Prom. For males, dress slacks, collared shirt, tie, coat and/or dress sweater are recommended. Females should not wear dresses that expose an excessive amount of skin in the chest or stomach areas and the dresses should not be too short. **Students can be asked to leave the dance if dressed inappropriately.**
5. If there is any suspicion of use of alcohol or illegal drugs at Prom, parents will immediately be called and students will receive consequences by the administration. There will be a breathalyzer at the dance and any student who seems impaired can be breathalyzed.
6. Dancing must be appropriate. Disrespectful dancing could result in the students being asked to leave the dance.
7. All students are reminded that Prom is a Purcell Marian function and all school rules and regulations, especially those regarding behavior and respect, are in effect.
8. Purcell Marian students who chose to bring a student from another school are responsible for their guest. Guest cannot be older than 19. No freshman will be allowed to attend Prom and sophomores must be asked to go.

Failure to comply with the above regulations and procedures, as well as all Purcell Marian rules for appropriate behavior as stated in the Student Handbook, may result in a student receiving school consequences from the Dean of Student Life.
