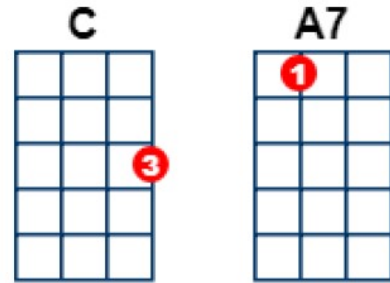
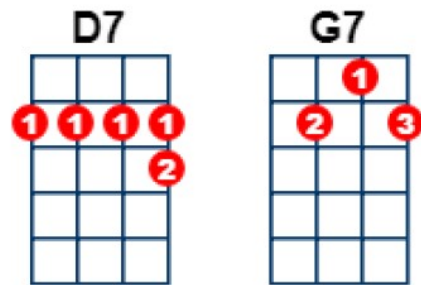

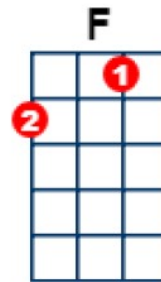

Do an 'ami'ami for the boys in the band (HEY!)



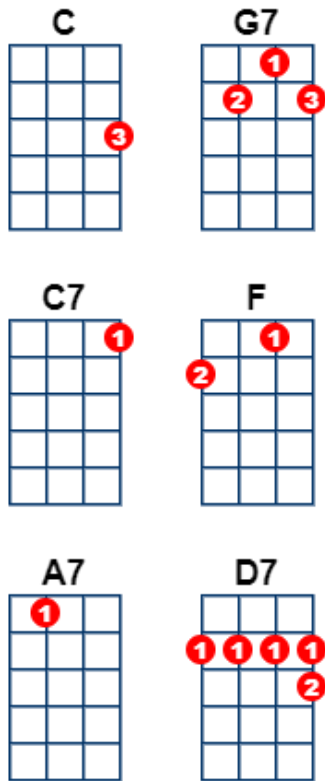
