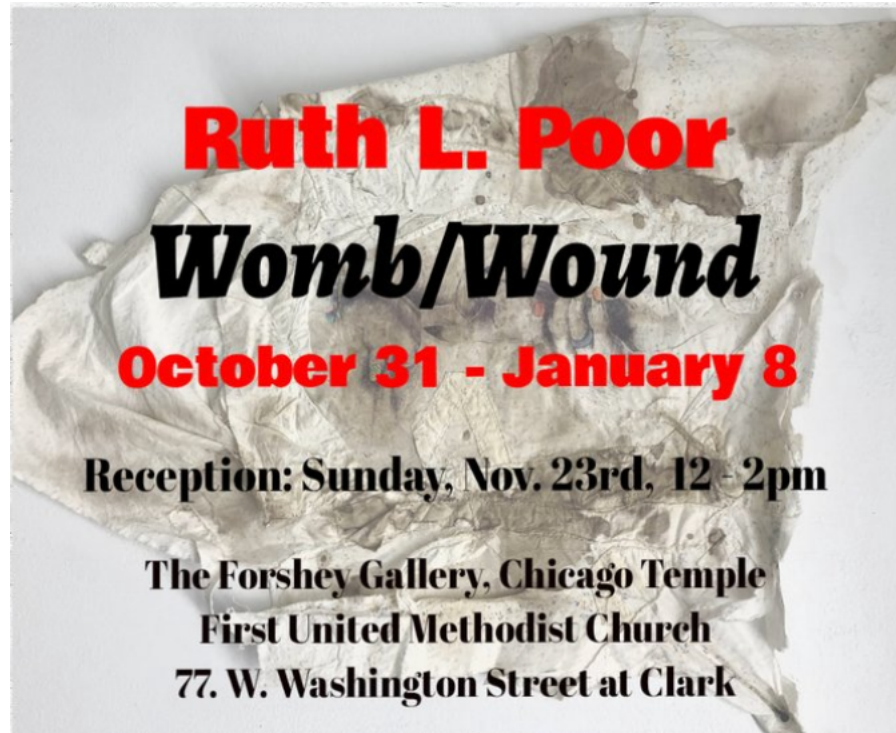




The next exhibition at the Forshey Gallery will be "Womb/Wound" by Ruth L. Poor.

An interdisciplinary artist, Poor embraces an evolving process of creation rooted in research and journaling/sketching as observation. Poor received their MFA from the Painting & Drawing department at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago (SAIC) and completed their B.A. in Studio Art and Religious Studies at Cornell College and DePauw University. They currently reside in Chicago, Illinois, where they teach at SAIC, North Central College, College of DuPage, and with the Prison + Neighborhood Arts Project. They have shown work nationally and internationally.
