The Wall That Heals



On Veterans Day 1996, the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund (VVMF) unveiled The Wall That Heals, a traveling replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C. This moving exhibit has been displayed in nearly 700 communities across the United States, sharing its profound healing legacy with millions.

Bringing The Wall That Heals to communities allows the souls enshrined on the Memorial to exist once more among loved ones in familiar surroundings. For many veterans, this offers the strength to confront their memories, fostering healing and reflection.



The Mobile Education Center
