DOCUMENT TO PERMIT THE SELLING OF HAMETZ

If possible, all hametz-food not acceptable during Pesach (Passover), or materials containing such unacceptable food, should be destroyed or given away before the holiday begins. Should this be impossible, the hametz may be stored in such a way that it will not be used during the holiday and its actual ownership is transferred to a non-Jew until the holiday ends.

Please complete the contract below and return it to the synagogue office no later than 12 Noon, Thursday, April 18, 2019.

I the undersigned, fully empower and permit Rabbi Mitch Parker to act on my behalf to sell all hametz possessed by me, knowingly or unknowingly, as defined by Torah and rabbinic law, and to lease all places wherein hametz owned may be found. This transaction will be in effect for the duration of the Passover holiday, which this year begins with sundown, April 19, 2019 and concludes after sundown April 27, 2019.
