Covid-19 Directive No. 5

Approved by Session on May 14, 2020

The church's Covid-19 Task Force met on Tuesday, May 12, 2020 in the library at the church. Social distancing was practiced. The task force presents the following recommendations and information to the Session:

1. The directives regarding no facility usage by church or tenant groups, staff working from home practices, electronic communications with the Congregation, and liv-streamed, recorded Worship Services as contained in Session's prior Covid-19 orders shall continue through Sunday, June 7, 2020, when virtual Communion will be presented.
2. Rev. Dr. Jody Moore will take Sunday, June 7, 2020, off. He has not yet had a Sunday off in 2020 and he has six Sundays per year that he can use.
3. Worship Moderator Nonie Booth will secure an ordained minister, who is qualified to prepare and serve the Sacrament of Holy Communion, for the Worship Service on June 7, 2020.
4. If the way be cleared and if the State of North Carolina allows and pursuant to guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control, the task force will begin working on "phased re-opening" recommendations for Session's consideration prior to June 14, 2020 with the potential of offering in-person worship beginning as early as June 14, 2020.
