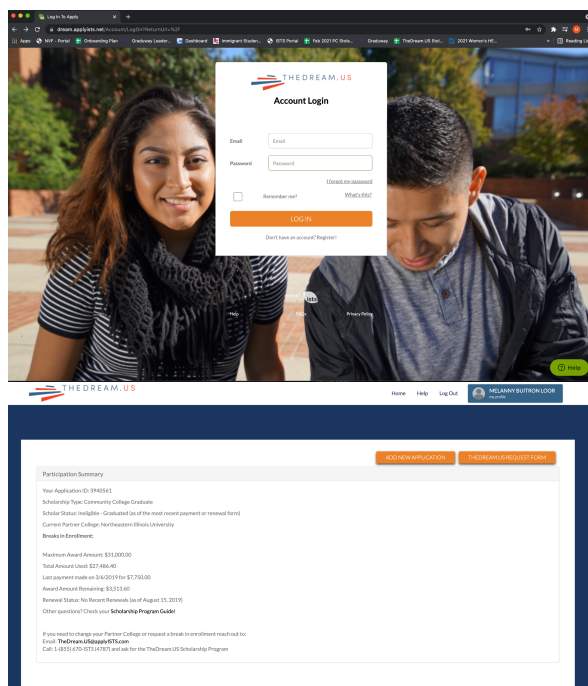

I was born and raised in Los Angeles to Mexican immigrant parents and come from three generations of migrant farmworkers. As a first-generation college student, I am the first in my large extended family to receive a doctoral degree. I am a psychologist serving undocumented students.

Despite the odds that come with immigration and working-class status, my eldest cousins graduated from UCLA, and my aunt received a Master's Degree, becoming my very first mentors. I could not imagine reaching my educational and career aspirations without them.

I hope that you, too, will seek support throughout your educational journey and consider me as a resource.

I can help:

- If you feel depressed, anxious, worried, overwhelmed, hopeless;
- If you need a referral to a mental health provider;
- If you want to create a self-care plan;
- If you are struggling with any other mental health issues.

MODERN STATES

[Modern States](#) offers over 30 tuition-free online courses which prepare students for the College Board (CLEP) exams. If you pass the exam, you may get credits at your college in place of paying for the same class on campus.

CAREER SUCCESS

PARKER DEWEY

Parker Dewey connects Scholars to employers who offer paid Micro-Internships – small work projects where Scholars and Graduates can demonstrate skills, explore career paths, develop a professional network and build your resume. Unlike a traditional internship, these projects typically range from 5 to 40 hours of work, and many can be completed remotely/virtually. As an example, the average salary for a 20-hr project is around \$360.

YOU SCIENCE

YouScience takes Scholars through a series of fun brain games to identify aptitudes (abilities most important to career success). Results include a review of natural strengths and interests with personalized matches to majors and careers (with information like salary, education required, job prospects, etc.).
