November 1st: beginning sound “c” (hard ‘c’ as in cat)
November 8th: beginning sound “t”
November 15th: free choice
November 29th: geometric solids

December 6th: beginning sound “h”
December 13th: beginning sound “r”
December 20th: December holidays/winter break

January 10th: free choice
January 17th: beginning sound “p”
January 24th: things that “go-together”
January 31st: beginning sound “g” (hard ‘g’ as in *gold*)

February 7th: beginning sound “f”
February 14th: *No Show-and-Tell due to Valentine’s Day festivities*
February 21st: beginning sound “n”
February 28th: reptiles and amphibians

March 7th: beginning sound “d”
March 14th: beginning sound “l”
March 21st: beginning sound “z”
March 28th: Spring

April 11th: opposites
April 18th: beginning sound “j”
April 25th: beginning sound “v”

May 2nd: nature
May 9th: rhymes
May 16th: beginning sound “k”
