Holy Monastery of Epano Chrepa



The Epano Chrepa Monastery is located at an altitude of 1278 meters on a verdant slope of Mainalo Mountain that offers a wonderful panoramic view of the city of Tripoli. It is the highest monastery in the Peloponnese and is therefore called the "balcony of Tripoli".

The monastery was founded and built during the late Byzantine Era, around 1100 AD, in order to honor Panagia Epanochrepitisa. It was a men's monastery until April 1935. Today it is home to a small and hospitable sisterhood of nuns who often lead charitable initiatives, organize food drives, fundraise, and provide support for those in need.
