Dear Saint Mary Magdalene Catholic School Families,

Parents interested in remote learning for their student(s) will have a virtual learning opportunity for the 2021-22 school year. The Diocese of Raleigh Office of Education would like to gather information from parents regarding their interest in a 100% Catholic virtual school beginning mid-August 2021.

This school will be administered by the Office of Education in partnership with a virtual school vendor. Enrollment would be through the Office of Education and the school will not have a physical campus. If you currently have children attending a Catholic school that will be offering a remote learning opportunity for the 2021-22 school year, enrollment in the Office of Education virtual school will not be an option.

Classes are generally offered between the hours of 11am - 2:30pm and may include other Catholic school students from other cities and states. As this is a 100% virtual school, there would be no option for changing enrollment from 100% virtual to a physical Catholic school during the school year. Because the program is virtual, there will be no extra-curriculars, sports or school events or programs.

Basic tuition for the Diocese of Raleigh Virtual School will be*: Elementary grades K-5 \$6,050/year Middle school grades 6-8 \$6,790/year Middle school electives (in addition to one offered in the standard schedule – additional electives may be available for \$500 per course/per semester (2 semesters per year = \$1,000)
