



## ***Volunteer Roles: What can I do?***

The overall mission of COS is to build the biggest conservative grassroots organization that has ever existed. But we need your help as a volunteer.

As a volunteer for COS, there are many ways you can get involved. No matter how much time you have, or your skills, we have opportunities to get engaged in the fight. The only requirement? A passion to save the country and do your part. Here is how you can help:

1. At a minimum, every COS supporter is asked to do the following:
  - a. Spread the word about COS – send friends, family, colleagues to the website ([Take Action](#) page) and have them sign the petition and volunteer. If they want a change, they need to get involved.
  - b. Contact your NC house representative and senator and ask them to support the COS resolution...by phone, email, or hand written letters(preferrable). Don't know who that is? Go to [www.ncleg.gov](http://www.ncleg.gov) and select "Find Your Legislators" on the top right corner of home page.
2. Want to get more involved? A great first step is to go to the Take Action page on the website and complete the [Volunteer](#) application. This is your gateway to get involved.
3. Want to make phone calls? We need you! Become a Telepatriot Volunteer. Load the [COSAction](#) phone app on your phone.
4. Become a Follow Up Team Member. As an FUT team member, you will help welcome new [petition](#) signers, and educate them on ways to get involved.
5. Help out at gun shows and other events where we have table-top displays. Attend rally days in Raleigh.

6. We have many districts where we need [District Captains](#). This is a key leadership role. DCs are responsible for building the grassroots and establishing a relationship with the local NC house representative. The only requirements are a 1) a passion to save the country, 2) internet access and basic computer skills, and 3) about 10-20 hours a month of time.
  - a. Or you can become a DC Team Member and assist an existing District Captain.
7. Become a member of block walking team. Block walking is an important tool we use to educate the public and influence legislators, and a way to bypass the challenge with getting the word out in a world where conservative voices are often censored.   - c. *Prayer Warriors* – There is a spiritual battle for this country. We need prayer more than ever.
  - d. [Legislative Liaison Team](#) – Enjoy engaging with politicians? Help with the interface between legislators and our supporters.
  - e. [Videographers](#) – Have video production talents? Work with the national media team to create state video content.
9. Get involved in your local community. Volunteer with your local county political party, or work for a candidate you support. Run for a local office. This is how we can change the direction of this country – it starts at the local level.
