

Gathering Petition Signers at Gun Shows and Other Events

One of the primary purposes in participation in gun shows and other events is to educate attendees on COS and then have them sign the petition. There are three ways to do that (note that it is suggested you be logged into CB before clicking on the links below):

1. If you have a computer and an internet connection, the preferred way is to use the [petition link](#) as this will allow you to input the information directly into the system just as if they had gone online themselves to the website. The petition link requires you to first sign in to Citizen Builder as normal. Once you do that, open the petition link. Be sure you create a tag describing the event at the bottom of the page. As you enter petition signers, and after you submit the name, then the page will automatically refresh and be ready for the next petition signer.
2. If you have a computer with Excel, but no internet connection, then the next best way is to use the [import template](#). This will allow you to enter the information for a petition signer into this spreadsheet. After the event, you will then need to [upload](#) this data to National for import into the system.
3. As a last resort, you can use [paper petitions](#). It is suggested that you fill these out to ensure the information is accurate and you can read it. You will then need to use the petition link or the Excel template to upload the data manually after the event.
