The registration fee will be \$450 per person. Meals for guests will also be available for additional charges. The registration form will be sent separately soon as the hotel is making menu changes which has affected our ability to complete additional meal cost charges.



The room block opens on March 10. Please use the link in this Call to Convention to reserve your rooms. The Quebec Hilton has stunning views no matter which side of the hotel your room is located. You can see historic sites, mountains, and the St. Lawrence Seaway. The hotel was completely remodeled prior to our original dates in July 2021.

Convention will begin on Wednesday evening with our Opening Banquet and close at the end of the Installation Banquet on Saturday evening. During the week we will have keynote speakers, excellent workshops, business sessions, a wonderful Foundation luncheon, a moving Celebration of Life for the Altrusans we have lost this biennium, and an optional event that will be educational as well as entertaining. And maybe most importantly, Convention will give us an opportunity to reconnect as Altrusans and meet new Altrusans attending Convention for the first time. You are encouraged to come early, or stay after the Convention to explore this beautiful city. No matter what side of the hotel you are on, you will have breathtaking views – either Parliament/Old Quebec City, the Saint Lawrence River or the mountains. Remember you will need a passport, and plan to pay with your credit card to get the best rate at the hotel due to the currency exchange rate.

President Linda has planned a fun and informative Altrusa International Convention. President-Elect Chris DeVlieger and her team have planned informative workshops that you won’t want to miss.

The Quebec Airport (YQB) has most major airlines flying in, except Southwest. There is no shuttle from the airport so consider using Uber, Lyft or town car service for transportation to and from the airport. If you will be driving to Convention, the hotel does provide valet as well as self-parking in their parking garage.

Quebec City weather in July will be in the middle to high 70s and lows in the 50s, so bring comfortable clothing, but also throw a sweater or light jacket into your luggage. We know the hotel meeting rooms are usually cold. Many of you said you weren’t coming to the last Convention due to the heat in Texas. We won’t have to worry about that in Canada.

Wednesday evening will feature our Opening Banquet, Thursday morning will be the Awards Breakfast, Friday Foundation Luncheon and Friday Night will be the optional event. The installation banquet will be Saturday night.

Our Friday night event will be at the hotel and will feature our “Rocking the Tartan” to celebrate the history and culture of Quebec City. Find your family tartan and wear it Friday night. 


