

BE a “Saint Cecilia in the Making” - 2021 Songwriting Competition

This is for Grade 4-8 only! There are two sets of words you can set to music. Each is on its own page. If you choose Option A, set the chorus and one verse. If you only get the chorus or the verse done, submit it anyhow!

Option B is just verses- so set one verse only.

Please submit your entry in one of the following ways:

- 1. Record yourself or a friend singing/playing it. The best file format is .mp3, but .mp4 may be okay.**
- 2. Use Bandlab to sequence your composition and share that.**
- 3. Use old fashioned pencil and paper- you can write stick notation (line, ‘staple’) etc. above the words, and write solfa (do re mi) or notenames (G, A, etc) under it. You can use [manuscript paper](#). Bring the actual paper when finished to the music room!**
- 4. Co-authorship is allowed- no more than 2 working on a piece.**

If it’s a big recording(large file), place in your “My Drive” and share a link. Deadline: Wed. December 15, 2021

Prize: Winning song(s) will be performed at a whole school mass.

Judging: Mrs. Schmitz will make the final decision. I reserve the right to combine parts of more than one piece if it makes sense. I may share a recording of me singing the top entries and ask other staff members their opinion, without telling them who composed it.
