Important Information Regarding the Writing of Final Exams from June 15 to June 27, 2018

- Students are to wear their full school uniform for the writing of exams.
- Students are to report to their morning homeroom (at the usual time) before exams commence.
- Students are to bring all the necessary implements for the writing of each exam.
- Only accommodations that are approved in advance, by the school, are permitted during exams.
- The time allotted to and procedures provided for Provincial Achievement Tests and Diploma Examinations are regulated by Alberta Education. These regulations are adhered to by the Clear Water Academy.
- Our internal school assessments align with provincial standards, and our assessment durations are as follows:
 - All **senior high** school assessments are expected to take **2 hours** to complete, with a **writing time of 3 hours** provided to complete them (except for Diploma Exams, we follow the time allotted by Alberta Education).
 - All **junior high** school assessments are expected to take **1½ hours** to complete, with a **writing time of 2 hours** provided to complete them (except for grade 9 PAT's, we follow the time allotted by Alberta Education).
- All assessments begin at **9 am**, and the minimum duration a student must stay is **120 minutes**. Students will not be allowed to leave the exam room until **11:00 am**.
