Dear Parents of Secondary (Grades 7 to 12),

The gist of this update is to start outlining how the end of the year will unfold for all secondary students and families. While there are still many variables surrounding our present situation, the Secondary Faculty have been engaging in dialogue focused on the best ways to bring closure to this academic year of 2019/2020. Therefore, please be informed of the following decisions:

Last Day of Classes:

- June 12, 2020, will be the last day of our CWA Interim Home Learning classes for all Junior High and High School students.

Final Exams:

- There will **not** be any final exams administered in Junior High and High School.
- As Alberta Education has already announced, **no** Provincial Achievement Tests (PAT's) in Grade 9 will be administered, as well, **no** Diploma Exams will be written.

June 15 to 26, 2020:

- Under normal circumstances, this time would be dedicated to the administration of final exams.
- While the final exams will not take place, we do expect that all Junior High and High School students will be available during these two weeks so that we can bring closure to the year with regards to report card distribution, the returning of textbooks, locker clean-out, and other tasks that will be determined.
- A schedule of events for these two weeks will be communicated to you as soon as possible. All activities requiring that students or families come to the school will be administered in accordance to all COVID-19 health regulations as dictated by Alberta Health Services.

June 24 and 25 (for Grade 12 students only):

- All Grade 12 students must be available on these days, so that we can allow for a modified celebration of their graduation from High School.
- Details of this plan are forth-coming.

I remind you that throughout this period of the COVID-19 Pandemic, with the implementation of the CWA Interim Home Learning program, the goal of the teaching faculty has been to provide a continuity of learning in all the classes taught. While the end of the school year is indeed in sight, our Secondary Faculty encourage all of our secondary students to remain engaged and committed to their learning until the last day of classes.
