PAYMENT PLAN

The offered *payment plan* option is a courtesy to our parents who prefer to stagger payments. It is not a monthly payment but rather *installment payments* for the semester, and as such, *are owed and will be billed accordingly.*

REFUND POLICY *PLEASE READ CAREFULLY*

Withdrawals more than 3 weeks before the first day of class will receive a tuition refund less a \$40 processing fee. Withdrawals less than 2 weeks before the first day of class will be charged a \$50 cancellation fee in addition to the \$35 processing fee.

Once the semester has begun, there are no refunds given due to non-participation for any reason. No credits or refunds are issued for the non-refundable Facility or Payment Plan Fees.

If due to a long-term illness or injury a student cannot complete the full class series, a partial pro-rated credit may be applied to the cost of future participation. *No refunds.* Any credit issued due to injury or illness is valid for the concurrent semester only. If not used during the concurrent semester, credit becomes forfeit.

Tennis Futures! Tennis & Swim Camp – Ages 5 – 10 years (Summer)

The goal of the program is to instill excitement and a desire to make tennis a lifetime activity. Focus is on hand eye and group participation skills along with basic introduction to the fundamental grips and swings. Emphasis also on hand eye coordination, movement, racquet control, along with basic technique of groundstrokes. Activities conducted with several teaching aids including tees, tennis mates, and the footwork court. More advanced players join the Intermediate class for instruction and then rejoin camp for swimming. Swimming is free time, not instructional, with certified lifeguards on duty.

INTERMEDIATE – Beginner/Intermediate players continue work on the refinement of basic tennis skills. Drills and rallying are introduced to simulate match play situations along with strategic patterns of play. Activities conducted with several teaching aids including tees, tennis mates, and a footwork court. Mental toughness skills introduced as they pertain to match play. The first four weeks of the program will be drills and rallying with red balls progressing to orange balls based on strokes, skills and rallying abilities.

ORANGE BALL - Summer class continues to build upon learned skills from Intermediate for the transition to Green Ball. **Registration is by approval only.**

GREEN BALL – Green Ball is the bridge class to Tournament Training. Continued refinement of fundamentals of movement, groundstrokes, volley, overhead, approach shots, and serve. Introduction to basic singles and doubles point play. **Green Ball student registration is by approval only.**

TOURNAMENT AND ELITE

TRAINING – Intense programs for goal-oriented junior players. Refinement of movement, balance and shot production are incorporated in match play simulation drills to help the player construct points. Video analysis and mental toughness training continues as a means of helping the players learn how to correct flaws and win matches. **New student registration is by approval only.**
