



# **Bike Rodeo Art Contest**

**Entries due Wednesday, Sept 5th by 9 am to Mrs. Munsie**

It's almost that time of year again when our little huskies compete to be the artist featured on the annual Bike Rodeo T-shirt! This year, students are encouraged to create their entries for the bike rodeo art contest at home, so we've put together a little packet to help guide their creativity. The bike rodeo theme this year is "Deep in the Heart of Hyer," and the T-shirt will be yellow.

Winners will be announced on the day of the bike stunt show, the week of October 6-10th. There will be one winner for each class, one winner for each grade level, and one overall winner that will have their art featured on the bike rodeo T-shirt!

## **Rules for bike rodeo artwork:**

- The art must be completed on white paper, either 8.5x11 or 9x12 size.
- The art must be in landscape format (wide paper, not tall).
- The art must include a bike in the drawing.
- The art must be original - no copying or having someone else do it.
- The art must be turned in on time - late entries will not be judged.

## **Tips from Mrs. Munsie:**

- Color like an artist! Fill in all the Space in your art by coloring in one direction and not leaving any white spaces.
- The past 3 winners have all had a full page of color, and not just a small drawing in the middle of the page. Color the whole page!
- The past winners have always stuck with the theme, and have all had a bike featured prominently in the drawing.
- It's ok to make mistakes and not get it right the first time. Just try it again, or turn it into a beautiful oops!
- Good luck! I can't wait to see what you create!
