PORT 101 - Elementary Portuguese I and PORT 102 - Elementary Portuguese II are an introduction to the Portuguese language and the cultures of the Portuguese-speaking nations of the world (Portugal - including the archipelagos of the Azores and Madeira - Brazil, Cabo Verde, Angola, Mozambique, Guinea-Bissau, S. Tome and Principe, East Timor and the Administrative Region of Macau) and are designed for students who have not formally learned Portuguese. Students develop basic communication skills in Portuguese in speaking, writing, reading, and listening.

Classes are held online and include synchronous sessions with the instructor. By the end of **PORT 101 and 102** students attain proficiency in the Novice range according to [ACTFL Standards](#).

***Attention Rhode Island College Students:**

PORT 102 fulfills the Second Language Milestone Requirement of General Education at Rhode Island College. Rhode Island College students may test out of PORT 101 and place into a higher level course by completing the [Online Portuguese Self-Assessment Test](#). (Please note: this test is only available to Rhode Island College students)

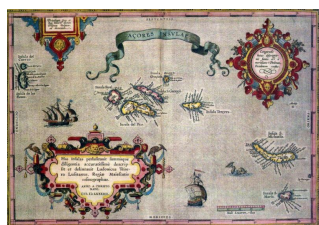

Portuguese 350: Literaturas e Culturas das Ilhas Atlânticas [Course # 30177]

Online - Summer Session I

May 18 - June 26, 2020

In Portuguese

The Portuguese Atlantic Islands comprise the autonomous regions of the Azores and Madeira. The Portuguese-speaking Atlantic Island Nations are Cabo Verde

and São Tomé e Príncipe. In this course we review their historic formation and development of identity in literature and expressive culture through weekly readings and discussions of primary and secondary texts, film and popular music. Students gain insight into themes of insularity, Atlantic cultural history, language, culture and diaspora.

Students also explore the literature and culture of islands and insular regions of Portuguese heritage located in other oceans, such as Timor-Leste (in the Indian Ocean) and Macau (in the South China Sea).

Designed for students of Portuguese at the proficiency level ranges of Intermediate-High to Advanced (ACTFL), the course includes practice of complex sentence structures, idiomatic expressions and stylistics.

This course is delivered online in Blackboard. Texts are available online in Blackboard and in James P. Adams Library at Rhode Island College.

Course prerequisite: PORT 202 or consent of instructor.

Attributes: counts for the Portuguese Minor and Major at Rhode Island College.
