

Cupertino Marianist Community
Covid Guidelines - Revised 01 July 2022
(Revisions and additions are in BOLD)

The following revisions/additions were made because of the continued decline in Covid cases **and to limit the contact of overnight and daytime visitors to maintain the wellness and safety of our elderly and high-risk brothers and staff.**

- A. All the resident brothers have been fully vaccinated.
- B. Because of the decline in Covid cases the wearing of masks in the house by the resident brothers is optional.
- C. All of our staff have been fully vaccinated; they continue to wear masks.
- D. No visitors are allowed if they have flu-like symptoms.**
- E. Overnight visitors:
 - 1. Will be tested if the person exhibits symptoms and or the person requests to be tested.**
 - 2. SM brothers, novices, and aspirants, and Province staff on official province business:
 - a. Must be fully vaccinated.
 - b. Are required to take a photo of their vaccination card and message it **24 hours prior to their visit to Grace Zollman (408.655.9441)**
 - c. Are allowed inside all buildings.**
 - 3. Lay Visitors (defined as those who are not SM brothers, novices, and aspirants, and province staff on official province business):**
 - a. **A maximum of 6 lay visitors may visit at one time. Three maximum in the Alcalde House and 3 maximum in the Bordeaux House.**
 - b. Their meals must be taken in designated areas only, such as the Community Room, Alcalde House, or Bordeaux House. The host brother is responsible to communicate with the kitchen staff to arrange for meals in these designated areas.**
 - c. Lay visitors are not allowed in St. Joseph Hall, St. Mary's Hall, Dining Room, or Chapel.
 - d. Lay visitors are not permitted inside a brother's room.
 - e. Lay visitors are required to always wear a well-fitting mask except during meals.
- F. Daytime visitors:
 - a. Must be fully vaccinated

- b. Are required to take a photo of their vaccination card and message it 24 hours prior to their visit to Grace Zollman (408.655.9441)**
- c. May visit with the brothers only in the large community room which is separate from the main house.
- d. Are required to always wear a well- fitting mask except during meals.**
- e. Face to face Marianist Affiliate meetings may take place only in the Community Room and are limited to a total of 15 participants.
