High School Spiritual Formation Trip To D.C

Trip Purpose Statement:

This Washington, D.C. trip is designed to help students explore what it means to **lead by serving others**. Through visits to the **Lincoln Memorial**, **MLK Memorial**, **World War II and Korean War Veterans Memorials**, as well as the **National Museum of African American History and Culture** and the **Museum of the Bible**, students will encounter inspiring stories of courage, integrity, and service.

The focus of the trip is **servant leadership**—learning how true leaders act with humility, put others first, and make choices that positively impact those around them. Guided reflections, journaling, and group discussions will help students connect these examples to their own lives and to the teaching of **Mark 10:43–44**, which reminds us that true greatness comes through serving others rather than seeking status or recognition.

This experience encourages students to see leadership not as a position of power or recognition, but as a way of life marked by service, responsibility, and care for others, equipping them to lead in meaningful ways at school, at home, and beyond.
