She previously served as the Minnesota Conference UCC Conference Minister (2013-2023), as Executive Director at the UCC's Back Bay Mission in Biloxi, Mississippi (2000-2013), and as pastor to local UCC congregations in Wheaton, Illinois and Stevens Point, Wisconsin. Shari's current duties leading the Love of Neighbor unit of the National Ministries of the United Church of Christ

include the oversight of 5 ministry teams: Global Ministries, Global HOPE (Humanitarian Opportunities. Partners. Empowerment), Gender & Sexuality Justice, the Office for Public Policy & Advocacy in Washington, D.C., and the United Nations liaison office. She has participated in and led multiple study trips to Palestine and Israel and has journeyed with Global Ministries delegations to Haiti, Columbia, Germany, Indonesia, and East Timor.
