Projects at the JCC:

1. Help cook meals at the JCC for the Jewish Group Home.
2. Create craft kits for Caitlin's Smiles. Caitlin's Smiles helps children with chronic and life threatening illnesses by giving them hope, laughs and smiles. The program encourages them to focus on creative arts activities that boost their confidence and self-worth.
3. Prepare PB&J sandwiches and decorate lunch bags for the Downtown Daily Bread.
4. Create cards for U.S. and Israeli soldiers.
5. Bake goodies for our community heroes. Show our thanks to the firefighters, police and other local community heroes.
6. Assembly butterfly snack bags to donate to a food pantry for those in need.
7. Make dog rope pulls and cat toys to donate to an animal shelter.
