- Ofrendas are offerings or “gifts” for the deceased, who, according to many cultures, visit on one magical day: Día de los Muertos.
- Ofrendas honor loved ones who have passed, including family, friends, pets, favorite authors or celebrities.
- Ofrendas include items that remind you of those who have passed including pictures, candles, flowers, animals, insects, rosaries, crosses, and foods that they loved.



- Sedona Public Library will have many items available for altar creation including shoeboxes, papers, glue, scissors, and more. Please feel free to bring your own items. (See list).
- Bring a paragraph telling the story of the loved one you’re honoring that explains why you chose them. This story will be attached to the BACK of your altar. Include YOUR name so boxes can be returned.
- Ofrendas will be displayed at the Library from October 18- November 1 &/or Tlaquepaque from October 28-November 1.



Consider Bringing:

- Shoebox
- Photographs
- Personal items the person enjoyed
- Candles (unlit or battery operated)
- Marigold flowers, real or imitation.
- Sugar skulls
- Construction, tissue, wrapping, or other papers
- Glue or tape to keep all your items in your box
- Popsicle or other decorative sticks
